Speaker: Jacquie B. Warda, Aerobatic Pilot

Topic: "Jacquie B. Airshows"

Jacquie Warda is an up-and-coming lady aerobatic pilot who, as a young girl, was always interested in aviation. Her father, a pilot, worked for McDonnell Douglas. Her formal flight training did not begin until she was 32, but she has made up for lost time. For the past 7 years she has competed in 10 to 15 air shows annually across the country, remarkable for a relatively new performer. Jacquie and her husband, David, also a pilot, own a Cessna 150 "Texas Taildragger" and a Pitts Special in which she performs aerobatics. The Pitts Special is one of three, specially built and painted, that flew around the Statue of Liberty on July 4, 1986, to celebrate its 100th anniversary. Jacquie says that her favorite part of any air show is the look on the faces of the children, especially the girls who, after seeing her perform, say, "I can do that or be a doctor or a scientist." Coyote Creek Trail

We will ride the Coyote Creek Trail starting from the Holiday Inn-San Jose-Silicon Valley. The ride will be about 6 miles to the Coyote Creek Golf Course. We will go past the golf course another 3 miles to a model airplane launching site, then double back to the golf course club house for lunch. After lunch we will ride back to the Holiday Inn for a total of 18 flat miles, round trip. For a shorter ride, you may omit the ride to the airplane site, thus reducing the roundtrip to 12 miles.

The Holiday Inn is located south of San Jose, one block east of highway 101 and just north of the highway 101/85 interchange. From either Highway 101 or 85, take the Bernal Road exit. Turn left on Bernal Road, which becomes Silicon Valley Boulevard after crossing over 101. Turn left on the service road next to the Holiday Inn and park there.
