PROGRAM

<u>Speaker: Jennifer Bucholtz, author and U.S. Army veteran</u> <u>Topic: Military experience and topics from her book.</u>

Jennifer Bucholtz served on active duty in the U.S. Army from 2000-2005 as a Counterintelligence Agent. She was assigned to several duty stations including Fort Carson, CO, Wonju, South Korea and Fort Meade, MD. Jennifer deployed to Egypt and Iraq while on active duty. After separating from the military, she continued to work for the Department of Defense in various Counterintelligence roles around the world. She spent fourteen months in Afghanistan from 2010 to 2011. Her daily duties involved extensive face-to-face contact with local Afghan men.



These experiences with the local populace serve as the basis for her book, *There is no Goat*. The book explores topics from the Afghan point of view including Politics, Osama bin Laden, the Afghan military and role of women in their culture.

Jennifer holds a Master of Science in Forensic Sciences and a Master of Arts in Criminal

Justice. She currently teaches courses in both of these disciplines for American Military University. She also volunteers with a veteran-based non-profit organization called *Team Rubicon* and devotes time to researching Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBIs) in military members.
